<u>15/1541C Solar Farm on land south of Wood Lane</u> – Approved with conditions.

<u>15/4039C The Stables, Bradwall Road</u> – Orangery/Conservatory. No comments or objections.

<u>15/4269C Hollins Green Farm</u> – Demolition of existing farmhouse and erection of replacement farmhouse and ancillary works. Comments to be submitted by 21 Oct 2015. The plans were examined and after discussion it was resolved that a statement of no comments or objections should be registered.

#### 8. TRANSPARENCY CODE

The Chairman demonstrated the website which is in the process of being constructed. The Clerk reported that a grant towards the cost of implementing the Transparency Code could be applied for. It was agreed not to submit an application for funding. The members thanked Cllr. Gnyp and Miss Katrina Gnyp for the work in building the website.
